TEN SLEEP — Cyrus E. Tolman, 86, died Monday, Oct. 19, in Billings, Mont.

He was born Dec. 16, 1894 in Star Valley to Frank and Eliza Tolman.

He first came to the area in 1903, settling first in Otto. He later moved to Ten Sleep where he has ranched since. He and a son, Gerald, owned and operated Sky Aviation for many years. He was a member of the L.D.S. Church in Ten Sleep.

two sons, Gerald Cyrus Tolman and Calvin Harris Tolman.
