



**Arnold Nelson (Swede) Egbert**  
1927 - 2020

Arnold Nelson (Swede) Egbert was born in Spring Creek, Wyoming on December 17, 1927 to parents John Egbert and Evaline Orbison Skinner Egbert. He was the youngest of four boys. He died January 4, 2020 in Spokane, Washington.

He was preceded in death by his parents and 3 brothers: Clifford Egbert, Emmett Egbert and Allen (Pat) Egbert. He is survived by 4 nieces (Charlotte Egbert Parsley, Marie Egbert Rendon, and Jo Egbert Zemke and Arlene Egbert Grant) and 1 nephew (Everett Egbert) as well as several great nephews and nieces and great-great nieces and nephews.

He served in the United States Navy from 1945-1947 and again from 1955-1959. After serving, he worked in Wyoming, Montana, Idaho and Washington as a ranch hand, cowboy, and field hand before settling into the Spokane Washington area. He worked for and retired from the State of Washington Department of Transportation on road maintenance.

He was a long-term member of the United Church of God and traveled several times to New Foundland and Nova Scotia for church-related activities. He was an avid photographer. He enjoyed taking his canoe to rivers and lakes in Washington, Idaho and Montana- taking photographs and being in the wilderness.
